MINUTES OF THE 49th NSSC MEETING HELD
ON 23rd JUNE, 2016

The 49th National Scheme Sanctioning Committee (NSSC) meeting was held in the conference room, Ministry of Drinking Water and Sanitation, 4th Floor Paryawaran Bhawan, CGO Complex, Lodhi Road, New Delhi under the chairpersonship of Shri Parameshwaran Iyer, Secretary, Ministry of Drinking Water and Sanitation, Government of India on 23rd June, 2016. The list of participants is given at **Annexure I**.

Secretary (DWS) welcomed all the members and officials present in the meeting. Additional Secretary (MDWS) mentioned that there is a provision of NSSC in Guidelines of SBM(G) and all State Secretaries in-charge of rural sanitation are members of the committee. The NSSC approves AIPs and PIPs of the States/UTs. It was also noted that the Baseline Survey was conducted in 2012-13. PIPs under SBM(G) is being decided accordingly. Thereafter, the regular items on the Agenda were taken-up.

Agenda items:

1. The minutes of the 48th NSSC meeting held on 11th June, 2015, were circulated vide letter no. S-11019/3/2015-SBM, dated 05.11.2015 earlier. No comments were received from anyone in this regard. The Committee, therefore, confirmed the Minutes.

2. The Committee reviewed the progress of Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin) implementation. Joint Secretary (Sanitation) informed that against the yearly target of **120 lakh** for individual household latrines of 2015-16, **127,41,367** latrines were constructed, which is achievement of **106%** of the target at National Level. Besides, **1907** Community Sanitary Complexes, have also been constructed.

3. Annual Implementation Plan (AIP) for 2016-17 under Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin)

Proposals from States/UTs of A & N Islands, Andhra Pradesh, Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Bihar, Chhattisgarh, Goa, Gujarat, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Jammu & Kashmir, Jharkhand, Karnataka, Kerala, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Manipur, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Nagaland, Odisha, Puducherry, Punjab, Rajasthan, Sikkim, Tamilnadu, Telangana, Tripura, Uttar Pradesh, Uttrakhand and West Bengal were discussed in the Committee. The details of physical & financial outlays approved of the projects are given in the tables below:

The Committee approved the Plans-subject to availability of fund and performance.

4. PIP Proposals from States/UTs have also been received and appraised. The proposal of Karnataka was approved as per the online data. It was also brought out that there is some difference in ineligible households. They were asked to justify the same and send revised proposals with approval of SLSSC. The State Co-ordinator, MP mentioned that data of few villages was not integrated and therefore the total PIP is changed. It was agreed that State proposal as approved by SLSSC may be approved subject to justification by the State about inclusion of the remaining household in the original data.

The proposal of Kerala was approved as per the online data. The State mentioned the requirement of amount for 2 lakh IHHLs. The State was asked to justify as to why this was not included in the Baseline Survey 2012. It was agreed that subject to justification, the proposal of State may be agreed. The fund for Rural Sanitary Mart/Production Centre including Revolving Fund is 5% of Project Cost. However, revolving fund at district will be maximum upto 5% of outlay subject to maximum of Rs. 1.5 crore per district. The project cost approved is total cost including cost of 2 crore toilets to be constructed under MGNREGS.
